## **Offering Altar Bread**

1. Bring the bread with you, as you attend the Vespers Service **the evening before.**
2. Place bread on the table in the Altar Servers Closet.
3. Bring white cloth (marked with your name) for the loaf Father returns to you.

## **Coffee Social**

**20 + dozen Pastry - One Variety / 3 gallons Orange Juice**

(for example: 20 lbs of grapes - if buying donuts- Dillons 15dz cut in half.  
Krispy Kreme 18-20dz +. Panera bagels 8 dz sandwich sliced)

- Coffee (regular and decaffeinated), coffee cups, juice cups, napkins, sugar and creamer are furnished by the Cathedral.
- Coffee will be brewed for you after Communion.
- The host(s) will pour juice and coffee.
- The host(s) will wash and put away any serving dishes used and wipe down kitchen. Also place dirty kitchen towels in dirty laundry hamper.
